What information we collect, use, and why

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

- Your right of access You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data.

• Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances.

• Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data

• Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the

right to withdraw your consent.
